THE LODGE

Business Casual

- Closed-toed shoes only
- **LADIES:** Nice jeans (no holes), khakis, dark pants and dress shirt or sweater
- **MEN:** Nice jeans (no holes), khakis, or casual dress pants with a button-down or polo shirt
- **DEER RUN PROVIDES:** a cap or hairnet (required) and a chef coat (stays at Deer Run)

THE CREEKSIDE

Casual — yet modest

- Closed-toed shoes only
- Jeans (no holes) or casual pants
- Plain casual shirts including t-shirts; only solid colors or patterns
- **DEER RUN PROVIDES:** a cap or hairnet (required)

WHAT NOT TO WEAR

BOTH Locations

- No open toed shoes such as sandals or flip flops
- No bandanas
- No tank tops, spaghetti strap shirts, low cut blouses, or sleeveless shirts
- No sweatpants or yoga pants
- No shorts, skirts or skorts
- No shirts with graphics or artwork except for Deer Run shirts
- No excessive holes in clothes
- No tight-fitting clothes
